



European Commission Selects J-PAL Europe to Evaluate Social Policies



J-PAL Europe has been selected by the European Commission's [Directorate General of Employment, Social Affairs & Inclusion](#) to help promote rigorous evaluation of social policies throughout the European Union (EU). Over the course of three years, J-PAL Europe, along with the Alliance for Useful Evidence and LSE Enterprise, will serve as a resource for social policy experimentation by establishing a web-based community of stakeholders interested in evaluating social policies, producing training tools to share knowledge about conducting rigorous evaluations, and providing tailored advice on social policy experimentation to EU member states or local authorities.

Advisory services and expertise will be provided by J-PAL affiliated professors Bruno Crépon (ENSAE), Marc Gurgand (Paris School of Economics), Michael Rosholm (Aarhus University), and Gerard van den Berg (University of Mannheim) along with J-PAL Europe staff on a number of topics, including:

- Employment (specifically youth and senior employment)
- Social protection and inclusion
- Improving working conditions with respect to health and safety
- Nondiscrimination and gender equality
